

AN AMENDMENT OR AMENDMENTS TO ORDINANCE NO. 95-5-1  
(AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING AND REVISING RULES, RATES,  
PROCEDURES  
REGULATIONS AND STANDARDS FOR THE OPERATION OF THE SANGAMON  
VALLEY  
PUBLIC WATER DISTRICT IN CHAMPAIGN COUNTY, ILLINOIS

June 15, 1999  
(Changes to be effective July 1, 1999)

The ORDINANCE is amended as follows:

DELETE that portion of Section **2.7 Payment Procedure**, which states:

For multi-family users, the period of delinquency is deemed to be 40 days after mailing

DELETE that portion of Section **2.8 Notice of Non-payment** which states

There will be a twenty percent (20%) penalty added to each bill that is unpaid by the due date. If any bills remain unpaid an additional 30 days, the water supply to the property affected will be shut off by the District after proper notification to the user. (For purposes of definition, "proper notification" shall be deemed to mean any conventional means of written communication). Service will not be restored until the delinquency and the penalty is paid in full. Payment of a \$25.00 re-connection fee will be necessary to restore water service.

SUBSTITUTE the following:

**2.8 Notice of Non-payment**

There will be a twenty percent (20%) penalty added to each bill that is unpaid by the due date. If any bills remain unpaid an additional 15days, the water supply to the property affected will be shut off by the District after proper notification to the user. (For purposes of definition, "proper notification" shall be deemed to mean any conventional means of written or oral communication). This constitutes a period of 45 days from the date the bill was originally mailed. Service will not be restored until the delinquency and the penalty are paid in full. Payment of a \$25.00 re-connection fee will be necessary to restore water service.
